### Your mission :

Working closely with the production and maintenance teams as well as with the client, you will be responsible for :

- Quality control of sandblasting and industrial painting operations on structures and equipment
- Verification of the compliance of surface preparations prior to application
- Control of environmental parameters: climatic conditions, dew point, humidity levels, substrate temperature
- Coating thickness measurements and follow-up of paint systems
- Inspection of sandblasting quality according to applicable standards and specifications
- Monitoring of standards, quality procedures, and client requirements
- Drafting of inspection reports, records, and quality files
- Identification and analysis of non-conformities, with a problem-solving and continuous improvement approach
- Support to field teams in the application of good quality practices
- Technical exchanges with the client and the various stakeholders on site

### Required profile :

- Specialised training in industrial painting, corrosion, materials, or surface treatments
- Profile ideally graduated from ITECH or an equivalent institution
- Initial industrial experience appreciated, particularly in the mining, metallurgy, industrial maintenance, energy, or offshore sectors
